## Introduction:

**Inclusive Education** means that all the students with special needs having different kind of disabilities are welcomed in the schools and learn the basic education, ethics, moral values, good behavior and many other things with the normal students in the class rooms. Every child in the world has equal right of getting primary education.

## Executive Summary:

Special Children in the society also have equal rights to get education so they can accommodate in society. With this perspective, **Child and Social Development Organization (CSDO)** and **Punjab Welfare Trust for Disabled (PWTD)** executing a project “**Inclusive Education Project**” in which 102 students is getting education and psychosocial support in 9 schools of CSDO located in slum and backward areas of Sialkot.

In these schools, special students sit with the other normal students in the class rooms for creating harmonization and healthy environment in which they can learn basics and other moral values. At start of every session, special syllabus is designed for these students according to their IQ level, sessions and trained the teachers that how to teach these kids by using different techniques and methodology.

### Working:

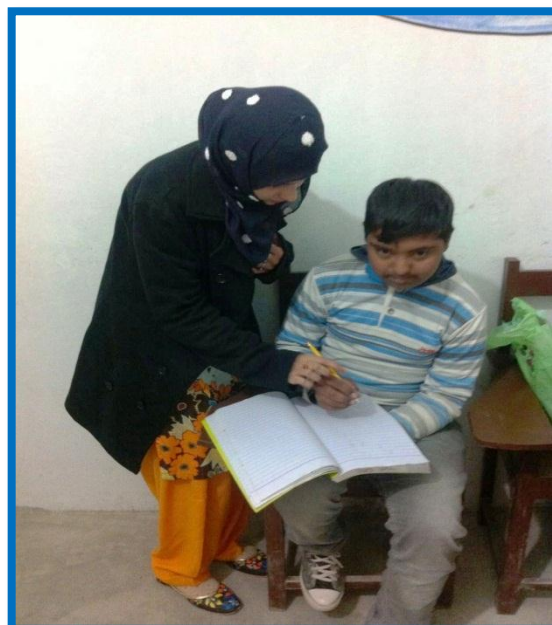
