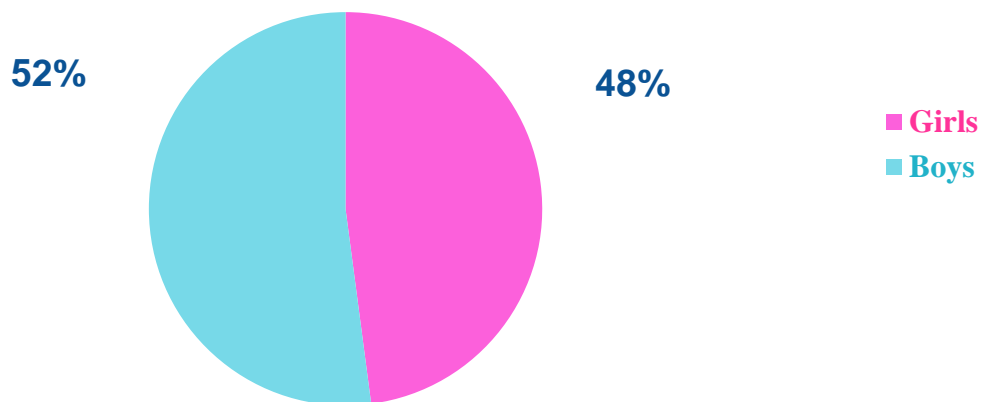
Summary of our major achievements during the period March 2015 to February 2016 is as under:

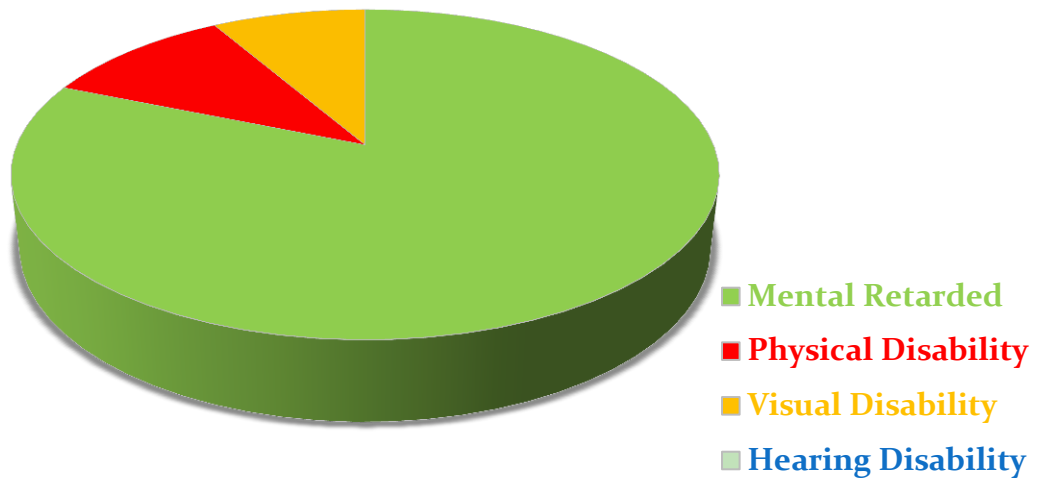
Gender-wise Current Strength of Special Students in 9 schools of CSDO

Highlights of the Project during the Period March 2015 to Feb.- 2016:

- General Communities of the selected project areas are better sensitized on the importance of education and Child Protection issues.

- The stakeholders especially the Sialkot Chamber of Commerce & Industry and the prominent industrialists of Sialkot have realized the importance of Inclusive education and sensitized to support the special children.
- Special Children have become more self-confident. They have learned to interact actively with their classmates and teachers and improved their communication skills.
- Parents feel relieved as their stress is shared.
- Community has realized the limitations of special children and provides services accordingly.
- Social problems have reduced in the selected project locations.
- Peer group/ Regular Students have developed supportive attitude with the special children.
