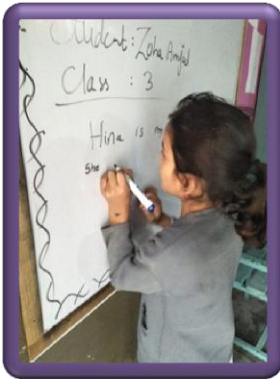

The key purpose of inclusive Education is to remove the inferiority

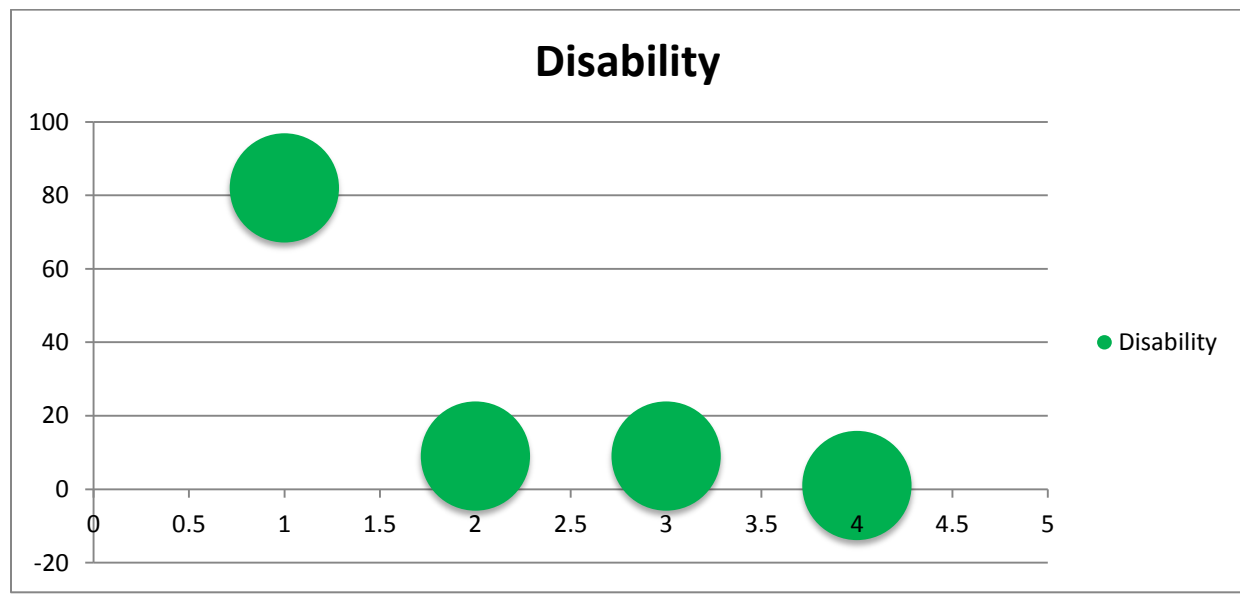
complex among disabled children and provide them a chance to enjoy the school life with normal students so they can enhance the self-confidence and adopt the things necessary for their survival in society.

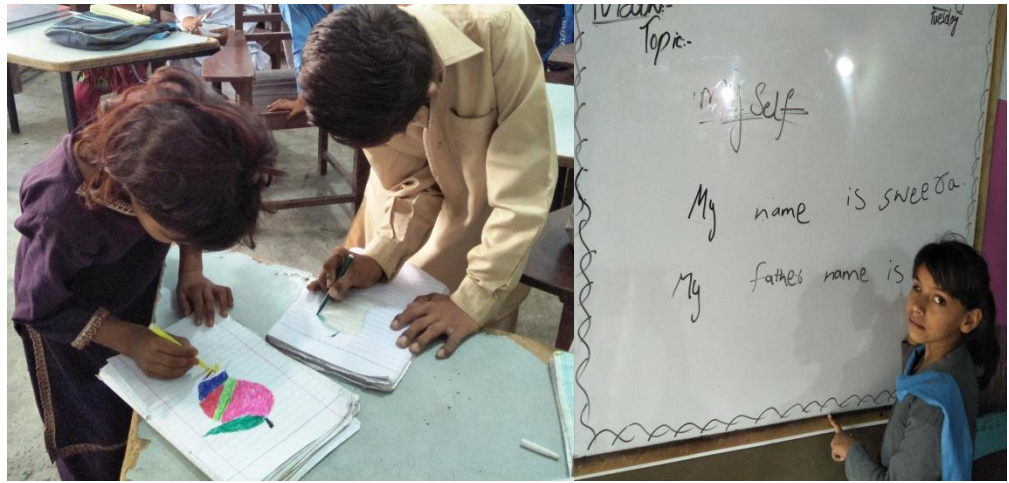

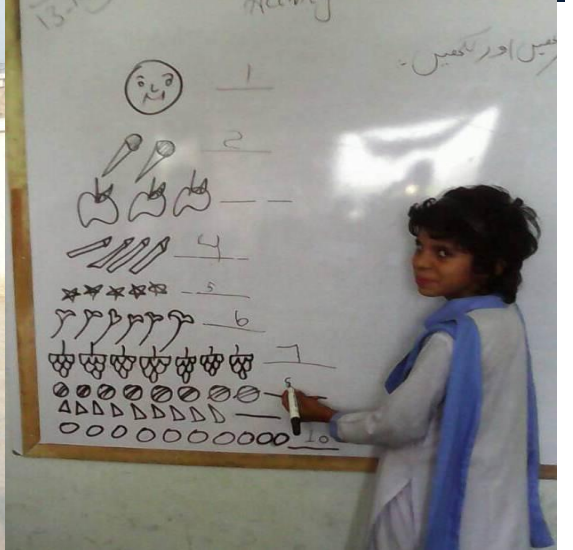
